Packaging inventory management (receipt, stocking, replenishment etc.), support shipping/receiving areas, and final product packaging.

Key Responsibilities:

- Accurate/timely data entry for GXP documents
- Coordination of shipping, receiving, storage and processing of goods.
- Inspect and verify material, labels, literature and documents for completeness and accuracy
- Ability to operate all applicable radiation detection equipment.
- Be able to record neat and accurate documentation.
- Complete applicable required job specific training, cGMP.
- Coordinate the pickup and destruction of both Non-hazardous waste and hazardous waste.

Shift: Sun-Wed, AM Shift. (12-Hour Shifts, rotating Wednesday's). Ability to work different shifts, weekends and overtime will be required.

Essential Requirements:

- High School diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum 1 year in Distribution, Warehousing, Manufacturing experience in a regulated industry. Hazardous shipping training a plus.
- Ability to use Microsoft office suite.
- Ability to lift or carry up to 35 pounds.
